# Problems

**Plastic packaging:** extremely wasteful (ends in landfills and is sent to oceans)

**Labor:** it takes time and money to clean, remove and transport the waste.

**Visual pollution:** packaging is left in streets, people litter and it is not pleasant aesthetically.

**Unsafe material:** some packaging materials contain toxic ingredients are wrapped in processed food packaging.

**Sustainability:** plastic bags are not biodegradable and take 1,000 to decompose.

# Solutions

**Recycling:** recycle any unusual, un-used, dry packaging. As a result, they stay out of landfills.

**Contacting companies:** Exposing companies' overpackaging leads to improvement and eco-friendly packaging.

**Letters:** A reason for litter is the fact that there are not enough bins. By reaching out to the government with a letter, can minimize waste and litter in cities.





# POP ART with J6
